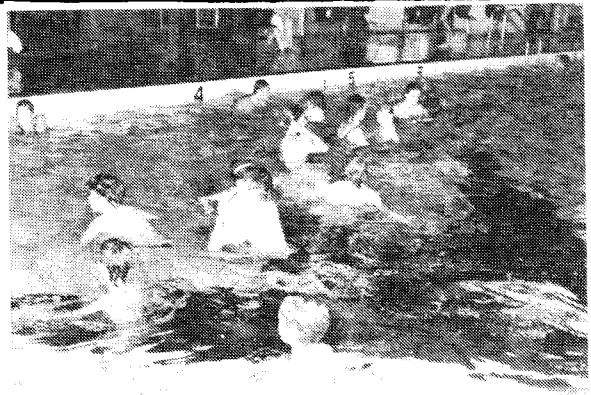

June 28th from 8pm to 11:30pm.

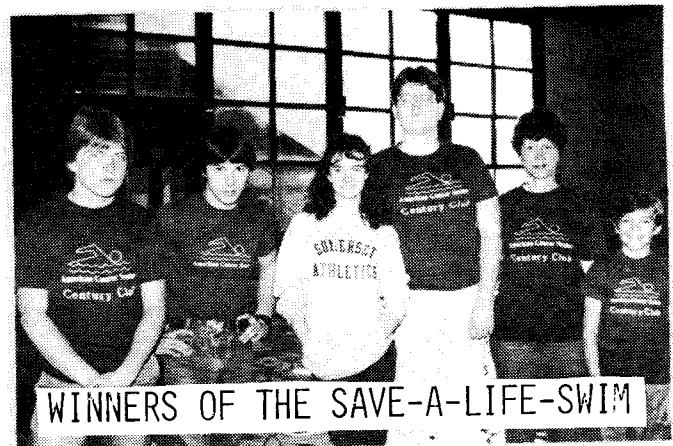
A DJ will provide the music.

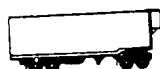

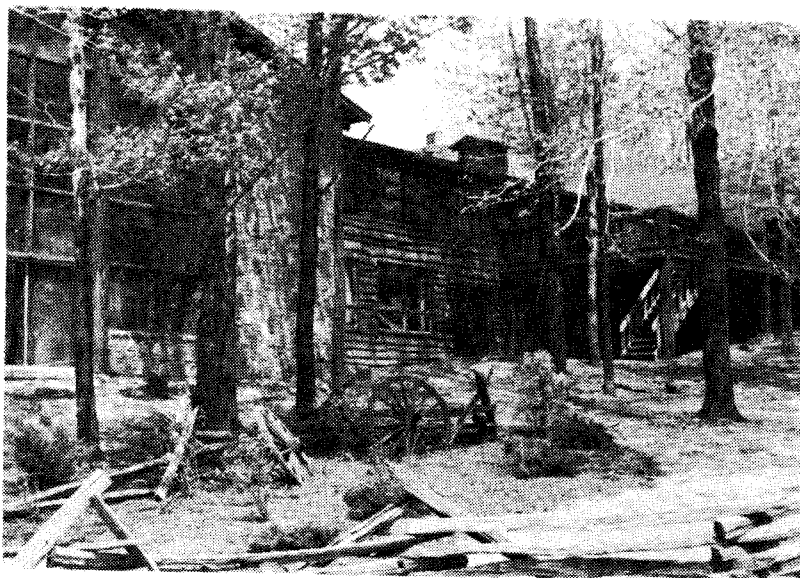
NEW FACES AT THE LODGE
