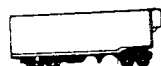

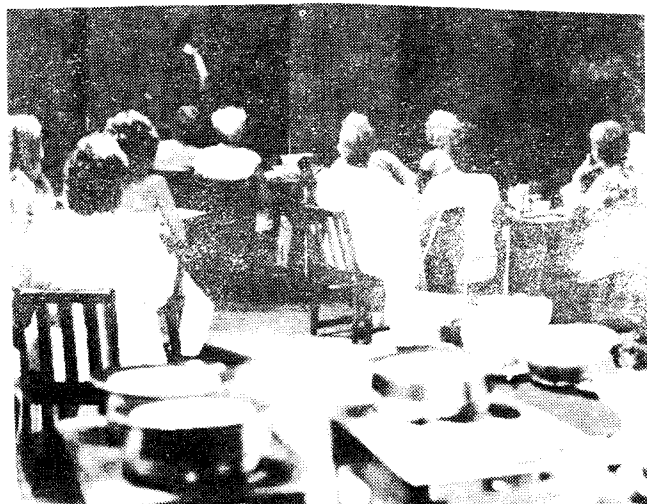

## NEW DINING ROOM TEAM

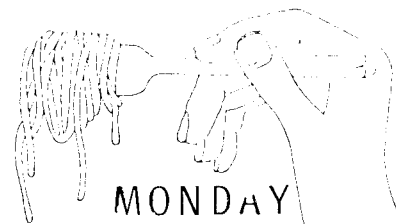

Chef Bob plans to start a Gourmet Club this fall and offer Gourmet Cooking Classes here.

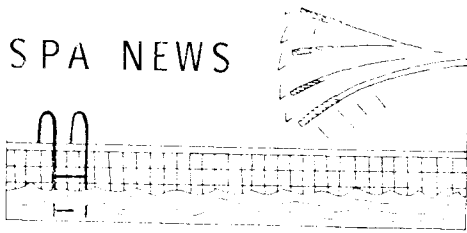

It's been a GREAT summer, but all good things must come to an end. The Pow Wow Pier will be closing its doors at 9pm on Labor Day.

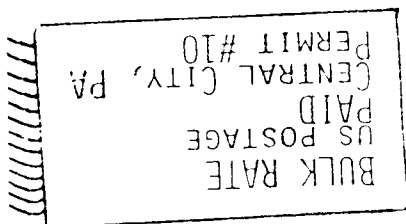
