New Billing System

Indian Lake property owners who charge, food entertainment and a variety of other services and merchandise should start to see an improvement in the billing system. The Lodge has joined with the Somerset Trust Company to process all billing through the bank's services.

Now, all charges made through the Lodge will be processed through the Master Charge program at Somerset Trust Company, Somerset, Pa.

A Master Charge account has been opened at Somerset Trust Company for each member of Indian Lake who is now charging goods and services.

Members may continue to use their present Indian Lake charge cards and will receive a complete record of charges made at Indian Lake. Because all Indian Lake billing will now be processed through Master Charge, any future charges by members will constitute acceptance of the Somerset Trust Company plan pursuant to the agreement which was mailed to members in April.

While some members may already have a Master Charge card, Somerset Trust Company will issue their own cards. Many members might prefer the locally issued card for general use in the Indian Lake area.

Overall, it is hoped that the arrangement with Somerset Trust Company and its Master Charge program will provide a more efficient billing system.

Indian Lake has a borough ordinance that prohibits littering and dumping of garbage anywhere in the resort.

Persons caught violating this ordinance could be fined as much as \$300.00. One sure way of avoiding the cost and embarrassment of a fine is to call Leonard Mostoller at 445-2815 for regularly scheduled garbage collection.

LODGE HAS NEW ENTRANCE



Progress on remodeling the Lodge has taken on a more definite shape as work is nearing completion on the new outside entrance. As shown above, the main entrance to the Lodge is now located on the side of the building facing the golf course. The huge deck that begins at the front end of the building widens out near the door leading into the Lodge. This will leave plenty of space for some tables and chairs for persons to sit and relax during the summer while enjoying the beautiful view of the 9-hole golf course and surrounding area. There is still some finishing work to be done before the new entrance will be considered complete.

The final phase of the remodeling program will involve changing the banquet room into the main dining room.

Site Cleared For New Townhouses



The site for Indian Lake's new townhouse vacation units has been cleared as final plans are being made for the start of construction. A total of 24 units will be built on this wooded site located near the Lodge, overlooking the ski slopes and lake.

The new townhouses will be built two and three units per building with the living area in each unit ranging from 920 to 1265 square feet.

Design for maximum flexibility in terms of interior floor planning, the townhouses will feature kitchen, dining area, and living room downstairs; bedrooms and bath upstairs. Kitchens will be complete with stainless steel sink, range, and two-door refrigerator.

Other features include wall-to-wall carpeting and sliding glass doors that lead to an outside deck. The units will be heated electrically and insulated for year 'round living.

Exterior of the buildings will be finished in a rustic combination of flitch siding, cedar shingles, brick and stone.

Both two and three bedroom unit may be purchased now at prices ranging from \$19,750 to \$24,750. Financing is available.

The townhouse vacation units are part of Indian Lake's original charter of 1500 property owners. Each townhouse owner will have boat docking space and access to Indian Lake's year 'round recreational facilities.

ANNUAL MEMORIAL DAY GOLF CLASSIC MAY 30-31

Indian Lake's sixth annual Memorial Day Golf Classic will be held Saturday and Sunday, May 30-31, on the 9-hole course next to the Lodge.

The Classic is an 18-hole event and golfers who enter the competition may play their round on either Saturday or Sunday. Scoring for the tournament will be based on the Calloway handicap system.

Francis Cmar of Latrobe will be after his third straight Memorial Day championship. Cmar, winner of four Indian Lake golf titles, won last year's Classic by shooting at four-over-par 73 that was good for a net 70 and a two stroke edge over former club champion Joe Parker. In 1968 Cmar beat out Tom Sproull of Pittsburgh.

The Calloway scoring method favors the high handicap golfer.
