

It appears that it's going to be a big year for snowmobiles at Indian Lake . . . now that snowmobile sales and service (including rentals) are part of the winter scene here for the first time.

The new snowmobile service is in full operation in the red barn at the game farm just across from Indian Lake's main entrance on Route 160. There's also equipment and accessories on display in the golf pro shop.

Even without snow, a considerable amount of interest has been generated among Indian Lakers and a number of snowmobiles - the popular Coleman Skiroule have already been sold.

OTHER FUN IDEAS

In addition to snowmobiles, a few other sporting ideas have been added to the line to make winter even more exciting.

One is the skibob. It's built like a bicycle on skis and is just as easy to handle. You can race down hills, fly over jumps or just make lazy loops in the snow.




